Click Add new filters.5. Name your filter.6. In the Set rules section, select "From" and "Contains".7. In the Type a filter value section, enter @the-scientist.com.8. Open the email the click on the sender name that appears next to the word From:4. Click Create New Contact.5. Click Done to save.6. Click Done again to return to the email.
<p>Mac Mail</p> 	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Open Mail app.2. Choose Mail > Preferences.3. Go to Junk Mail from the menu list along the top of your screen.4. Make sure Address Book, and Previous Recipients options are checked.5. Exit the Preferences Window.6. Add @the-scientist.com to your Address Book.app

Select: enable adaptive junk mail controls for this account4. Under 'do not automatically mark mail as junk if the sender is in:'<ol style="list-style-type: none">a. Select the address bookb. Select "Move new junk messages to"<ol style="list-style-type: none">i. If pop select: Junk folder on mail account nameii. If IMAP select 'Other' and Junk / Spam folder on IMAP mail account.c.
